< **BELDEN HOUSE & MEWS**

Litchfield, CT

Built as a private home in 1888, this new hotel consists of a mansion and mews that turn architectural eccentricities into opportunities, with banquette seating curved into bay windows and in-room minibars fashioned from old washbasins.

THE INN ON BILTMORE ESTATE

Asheville, NC

After a redesign, this retreat owes much of its charm to details faithful to the era when the Vanderbilts constructed Biltmore House on-site—think William Morris prints on rugs and wallpaper, and reproductions of the building's architectural drawings.

SOHO HOUSE

Nashville, TN

The former hosiery factory celebrates its industrial roots with Bauhaus-inspired interiors, exposed brick walls, and verdigris-hued headboards that nod to the building's original copper door.

^ **HOTEL PETER AND PAUL**

New Orleans, LA

Once home to a church, school, rectory, and convent, this bohemian boutique hotel is packed with personality. No two rooms are alike, but they all bring the drama, awash in jewel tones, lavish draperies, and antiques.

< **THE MANCHESTER**

Lexington, KY

The Distillery District mainstay creates a sense of place via details like the bourbon-stocked bar in the adult bunk room. On the rooftop—inspired by Florida in the 1960s—tropical touches transport guests to another horse capital.

Charleston, SC

This newcomer celebrates conviviality: Guests mingle over self-serve drinks in the checkered-floor lobby, linger amidst greenery in the courtyard, queue up records in the vinyl library, and end the night under the stars on a Riviera-inspired rooftop bar.

Find tranquility at this eco-friendly sanctuary, which sets a peaceful vibe with organic mattresses and locally sourced bed linens. Throughout, reclaimed timber, native plants, and moss art honor the environment.

HOTEL DEL CORONADO

Coronado, CA

Following a big reno, this beachfront legend offers a contemporary twist on Victorian style with blue-ceilinged rooms, floral prints, and stained glass windows.

MII AMO
Sedona, AZ

At this all-inclusive spa in Boynton Canyon, the focus is on cultivating comfort: Casitas boast fireplaces and heated bathroom floors, and the common-area “living room” features a coral velvet conversation pit. There’s beauty all around, especially by the outdoor pool with red rock views.



^ **COMMODORE PERRY ESTATE**

Austin, TX

Reimagined by designer Ken Fulk, this 10-acre gem blends European elegance and Southern hospitality, showcasing pattern-drenched suites in the original Italian Renaissance Revival mansion and charming, antique-filled rooms in the new inn on-site.

v **PALM HOUSE**

Palm Beach, FL

This getaway offers a refreshingly sophisticated take on Floridian pink, going for tropical glamour with a rosy facade and blush Murano glass chandeliers. Its elevated coastal style is embodied by floor-to-ceiling seashell installations from local artist Christa Wilm.

THE CLAREMONT HOTEL

Southwest Harbor, ME

Bordering idyllic Acadia, this iconic property ensures stunning views indoors and out. The pool overlooks enchanting Somes Sound, and the romantic rooms and cottages are embellished with Sister Parish wallcoverings and Pierre Frey fabrics.
